The Prius v concept stands for 'versatility'. It's designed to meet the needs of growing families with active lifestyles while providing the qualities found in Prius DNA. While its footprint is similar to the current Prius, it is an all-new vehicle with a more spacious interior - especially in the luggage compartment. Prius v concept also delivers the great fuel economy, low emissions and proven technology of its Prius heritage.

The Toyota FT-86 II concept sports car is a different machine altogether. For five decades Toyota has been creating exciting sports cars including the legendary 2000 GT. The FT-86 II concept previews the next generation of Toyota sports cars. It's a car that captures the joy of driving, having been designed for purists by purists. While it pays homage to Toyota's sports car history, it's soon to be a reality.

If the response at the Show is strong enough, these vehicles may be seen on Australian roads sometime next year.
